The VIPDC will conduct an approved Walking Field Trial on April 4th and 5th, 2020 at Springford Farm, 1884 Northwest Bay Road, Nanoose, Bay, BC. The Trial is held under the pointing breeds Field Trial and Field Dog Test Rules and Regulations, effective January 1, 2020, of the Canadian Kennel Club, Suite 400-200 Ronson Drive, Etobicoke, Ontario, M9W 5Z9 [Link to Rules](#)

Courses and Birds: All courses will be a single designated route. Chukar, Pheasant, Quail or alternate game birds will be released throughout the course for all stakes excluding puppy. In the advent of adverse course conditions, the Field Trial Chairman may adjust the course.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All stakes are walking stakes. Horses are neither required by handlers nor allowed. Blank pistols, .22 cal minimum will be fired over all dogs with bird work in the senior and derby stakes. Blank pistols may be fired over puppies if both handlers agree. No live ammunition will be allowed in any stake. Pistols must have solid barrels.
- Total entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in the available daylight hours
- The senior stakes will be 30 minutes in length; the derby and puppy stakes will be 20 minutes. The Club reserves the right to rearrange the running order of the stakes should conditions warrant
- Collaring a dog away after game contact will be allowed.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to run, at the end of the given stake. **Entrants must notify Event Secretary prior to the start of said stake, or run will be forfeited.**
- Tracking Collars: Approved electronic tracking collars may be used. Any questions regarding their use should be referred to the Field Trial Chairman
- All participants must be familiar with the CKC Rules and also the rules and provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Trial rulebooks are available from the CKC or on-line at the CKC website for CKC members.
- **GALLERY viewing** is at the discretion of the judge. The GALLERY must remain quiet and 50 feet behind the Judges and Handlers - **The GALLERY must not interfere with the Judges and Handlers.**
- **It shall be the duty and obligation of the Test-giving Club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or competitor at a Field Test is not subject to indignities. The Field Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.**
- The Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club is committed to providing an environment free of discrimination and harassment, where all individuals are treated with respect. Members and participants are expected to be respectful at all times. Harassment, discrimination, physical and verbal assault by anyone will not be tolerated, condoned, or ignored within our membership or at any event sponsored or hosted by the Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club. Any such claims will be reviewed by the Board. If a claim of harassment or discrimination is determined, disciplinary measures will be applied, up to and including termination of membership, or suspension from participation in future events for a length of time as determined by the Board.

PRIZES: Standard CKC rosettes and plaques will be awarded to the placing dogs in all stakes as appropriate.

LISTING FEE: A listing fee as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN), Performance Event Number (PEN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) is not shown on the entry form. This listing fee is per dog per each event entered during the Field Trial and is in addition to the entry fee(s).

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011 CKC Non-member participation fee.

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

All entries are accepted on the condition that the Vancouver Island Pointing Dog Club, its officers, directors, membership and landowners assume no responsibility for participants or spectators in the event of injury or damage to persons, animals, or properties in conjunction with or during the running of the Field Trial. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or guardian.

BORDER CROSSING: A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into or out of Canada and the rabies certificate must be dated at least 30 days prior to crossing the border.

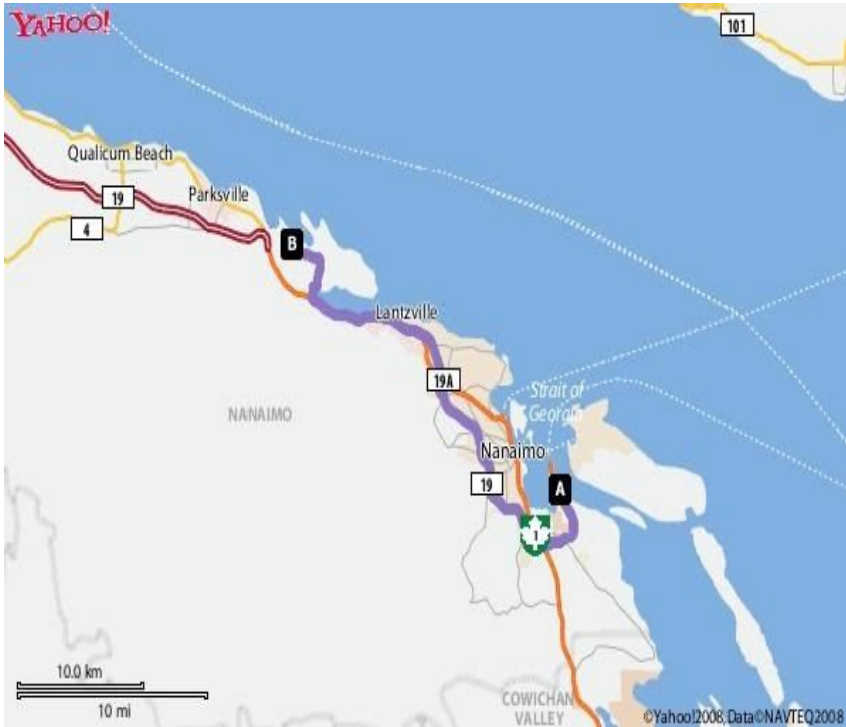

Field Trial Location: Springford Farm, 1884 Northwest Bay Road, Nanoose Bay, BC. Northwest Bay Road is located approximately 24 km North of Nanaimo on the Island Highway (#19). Access to Nanaimo on Vancouver Island is provided by BC Ferries from either Horseshoe Bay Terminal to Departure Bay just north of Nanaimo or Tsawwassen to Duke Point just south of Nanaimo. Please check with BC Ferries website at www.bcferries.com for official times and fares. Their website is very user friendly. Once you are off the ferry you will take Highway 19 North past Nanaimo until you reach Nanoose Bay, turn right at the light at the Petrocan Station (you are now on Northwest Bay Road). Continue approximately 5 kms until you see the pointing dog signs. Please follow the pointing dog signs to the west edge of the property and refrain from using the main drive to the house or barn.



There will be no exercising or training of any dogs on the Trial grounds before, during or after the trial without the explicit permission from the Field Trial Chairman.
